Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1646) to authorize appropriations for the Department of State for fiscal years 2002 and 2003, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 1646) to authorize appropriations
6 for the Department of State for fiscal years 2002 and

1 2003, and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill
2 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
3 eration of the bill are waived. General debate shall be con-
4 fined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equally di-
5 vided and controlled by the chairman and ranking minor-
6 ity member of the Committee on International Relations.
7 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
8 amendment under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order
9 to consider as an original bill for the purpose of amend-
10 ment under the five-minute rule the amendment in the na-
11 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
12 International Relations now printed in the bill. The com-
13 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be
14 considered as read. All points of order against the com-
15 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute are
16 waived. No amendment to the committee amendment in
17 the nature of a substitute shall be in order except those
18 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
19 panying this resolution. Except as specified in section 2
20 of this resolution, each such amendment may be offered
21 only in the order printed in the report, may be offered
22 only by a Member designated in the report, shall be con-
23 sidered as read, shall be debatable for the time specified
24 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
25 ponent and an opponent, shall not be subject to amend-

1 ment, and shall not be subject to a demand for division
2 of the question in the House or in the Committee of the
3 Whole. All points of order against such amendments are
4 waived. At the conclusion of consideration of the bill for
5 amendment the Committee shall rise and report the bill
6 to the House with such amendments as may have been
7 adopted. Any Member may demand a separate vote in the
8 House on any amendment adopted in the Committee of
9 the Whole to the bill or to the committee amendment in
10 the nature of a substitute. The previous question shall be
11 considered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto
12 to final passage without intervening motion except one
13 motion to recommit with or without instructions.

14 SEC. 2. The chairman of the Committee of the Whole
15 may recognize for consideration of any amendment printed
16 in the report of the Committee on Rules out of the order
17 printed, but not sooner than one hour after the Majority
18 Leader or his designee announces from the floor a request
19 to that effect.
