Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

---

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1157) to authorize the Secretary of Commerce to provide financial assistance to the States of Alaska, Washington, Oregon, California, and Idaho for salmon habitat restoration projects in coastal waters and upland drainages, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee

1 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
2 ation of the bill (H.R. 1157) to authorize the Secretary  
3 of Commerce to provide financial assistance to the States  
4 of Alaska, Washington, Oregon, California, and Idaho for  
5 salmon habitat restoration projects in coastal waters and  
6 upland drainages, and for other purposes. The first read-  
7 ing of the bill shall be dispensed with. Points of order  
8 against consideration of the bill for failure to comply with  
9 clause 4(a) of rule XIII are waived. General debate shall  
10 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-  
11 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-  
12 nority member of the Committee on Resources. After gen-  
13 eral debate the bill shall be considered for amendment  
14 under the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider  
15 as an original bill for the purpose of amendment under  
16 the five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
17 stitute printed in the Congressional Record and numbered  
18 1 pursuant to clause 8 of rule XVIII. Each section of that  
19 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be consid-  
20 ered as read. During consideration of the bill for amend-  
21 ment, the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may  
22 accord priority in recognition on the basis of whether the  
23 Member offering an amendment has caused it to be print-  
24 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated  
25 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments

1 so printed shall be considered as read. At the conclusion  
2 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee  
3 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such  
4 amendments as may have been adopted. Any Member may  
5 demand a separate vote in the House on any amendment  
6 adopted in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to  
7 the amendment in the nature of a substitute made in order  
8 as original text. The previous question shall be considered  
9 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final  
10 passage without intervening motion except one motion to  
11 recommit with or without instructions.
