Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2217) making appropriations for the Department of the Interior and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2217) making appropriations for

1 the Department of the Interior and related agencies for  
2 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for other  
3 purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed  
4 with. All points of order against consideration of the bill  
5 are waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill  
6 and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
7 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
8 the Committee on Appropriations. After general debate  
9 the bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-  
10 minute rule. Points of order against provisions in the bill  
11 for failure to comply with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived  
12 except as follows: beginning with “*Provided further,*” on  
13 page 89, line 13, through “participant:” on line 18. Where  
14 points of order are waived against part of a paragraph,  
15 points of order against a provision in another part of such  
16 paragraph may be made only against such provision and  
17 not against the entire paragraph. During consideration of  
18 the bill for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee  
19 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the  
20 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has  
21 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional  
22 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule  
23 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as  
24 read. During consideration of the bill, points of order  
25 against amendments for failure to comply with clause 2(e)

1 of rule XXI are waived. At the conclusion of consideration  
2 of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and  
3 report the bill to the House with such amendments as may  
4 have been adopted. The previous question shall be consid-  
5 ered as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to  
6 final passage without intervening motion except one mo-  
7 tion to recommit with or without instructions.
