RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the joint resolution (H.J. Res. 36) proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the United States authorizing the Congress to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the United States.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the joint reso-
3 lution (H.J. Res. 36) proposing an amendment to the Con-
4 stitution of the United States authorizing the Congress
5 to prohibit the physical desecration of the flag of the

1 United States. The joint resolution shall be considered as
2 read for amendment. The previous question shall be con-
3 sidered as ordered on the joint resolution and any amend-
4 ment thereto to final passage without intervening motion
5 except: (1) two hours of debate equally divided and con-
6 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
7 the Committee on the Judiciary; (2) an amendment in the
8 nature of a substitute, if offered by Representative Con-
9 yers of Michigan or his designee, which shall be considered
10 as read and shall be separately debatable for one hour
11 equally divided and controlled by the proponent and an
12 opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or without
13 instructions.
