Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2506) making appropriations for foreign operations, export financing, and related programs for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 2506) making appropriations for

1 foreign operations, export financing, and related programs
2 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for
3 other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall be dis-
4 pensed with. Points of order against consideration of the
5 bill for failure to comply with clause 4 of rule XIII are
6 waived. General debate shall be confined to the bill and
7 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
8 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
9 Committee on Appropriations. After general debate the
10 bill shall be considered for amendment under the five-
11 minute rule. The amendments printed in the report of the
12 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be
13 considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee
14 of the Whole. Points of order against provisions in the
15 bill, as amended, for failure to comply with clause 2 of
16 rule XXI are waived except as follows: page 75, lines 17
17 through 23; page 107, lines 11 through 17. No further
18 amendment to the bill shall be in order except those print-
19 ed in the portion of the Congressional Record designated
20 for that purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII and except pro-
21 forma amendments for the purpose of debate. Each
22 amendment so printed may be offered only by the Member
23 who caused it to be printed or his designee and shall be
24 considered as read. At the conclusion of consideration of
25 the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise and re-

1 port the bill, as amended, to the House with such further
2 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
3 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
4 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
5 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
6 structions.
