Ms. PRYCE, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3061) making appropriations for the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services, and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2002, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3061) making appropriations for

1 the Departments of Labor, Health and Human Services,
2 and Education, and related agencies for the fiscal year
3 ending September 30, 2002, and for other purposes. The
4 first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All points
5 of order against consideration of the bill are waived. Gen-
6 eral debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not ex-
7 ceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the chair-
8 man and ranking minority member of the Committee on
9 Appropriations. After general debate the bill shall be con-
10 sidered for amendment under the five-minute rule. Points
11 of order against provisions in the bill for failure to comply
12 with clause 2 of rule XXI are waived. The amendment
13 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
14 panying this resolution may be offered only by a Member
15 designated in the report and only at the appropriate point
16 in the reading of the bill, shall be considered as read, shall
17 be debatable for the time specified in the report equally
18 divided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent,
19 shall not be subject to amendment, and shall not be sub-
20 ject to a demand for division of the question in the House
21 or in the Committee of the Whole. All points of order
22 against the amendment printed in the report are waived.
23 During consideration of the bill for amendment, the Chair-
24 man of the Committee of the Whole may accord priority
25 in recognition on the basis of whether the Member offering

1 an amendment has caused it to be printed in the portion
2 of the Congressional Record designated for that purpose
3 in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed shall
4 be considered as read. During consideration of the bill,
5 points of order against amendments for failure to comply
6 with clause 2(e) of rule XXI are waived. At the conclusion
7 of consideration of the bill for amendment the Committee
8 shall rise and report the bill to the House with such
9 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
12 motion except one motion to recommit with or without in-
13 structions.
