Mr. REYNOLDS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3150) to improve aviation security, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3150) to improve aviation security,
6 and for other purposes. The first reading of the bill shall
7 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the
8 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-

1 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of
2 the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure.
3 After general debate the bill shall be considered for
4 amendment under the five-minute rule. The bill shall be
5 considered as read. No amendment to the bill shall be in
6 order except those printed in the report of the Committee
7 on Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-
8 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-
9 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the
10 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for
11 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-
12 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be
13 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-
14 mand for division of the question in the House or in the
15 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such
16 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-
17 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise
18 and report the bill to the House with such amendments
19 as may have been adopted. The previous question shall
20 be considered as ordered on the bill and amendments
21 thereto to final passage without intervening motion except
22 one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
