RESOLUTION

Encouraging the people of the United States to support the Armed Forces and civilian personnel who are engaged in the war on terrorism as part of a united effort to be known as Operation Enduring Support.

Whereas in response to the terrorist attacks on the United States on September 11, 2001, the United States is en-

gaged in Operation Enduring Freedom, which will require the men and women of the Armed Forces to engage and defeat terrorists, and which will require both military and civilian personnel to protect the Nation from further attack; and

Whereas it is imperative that the Nation support the Armed Forces and civilian personnel in such an effort: Now, therefore, be it

1 *Resolved*, That the House of Representatives—

2 (1) recognizes and commends the efforts of
3 State and local governments, and community, reli-
4 gious, and charitable organizations to support the
5 Armed Forces engaged in Operation Enduring Free-
6 dom, as well as civilian personnel who are also en-
7 gaged in the war on terrorism;

8 (2) encourages the people of the United States
9 to further support the Armed Forces and civilian
10 personnel through a united effort to be known as
11 Operation Enduring Support;

12 (3) encourages the people of the United States,
13 as part of Operation Enduring Support—

14 (A) to support the families of Armed
15 Forces personnel;

16 (B) to stage patriotic send-off and wel-
17 come-home rallies and parades; and

1 (C) to volunteer and contribute financial
2 assistance to the Red Cross, the United Way,
3 and other such organizations.
