# RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require that the expenses of special-order speeches be paid from the Members Representational Allowance of the Members making the speeches.

1       *Resolved*, That (a) rule XVII of the Rules of the  
2 House of Representatives is amended by adding at the end  
3 the following new clause:

4       “10. Expenses of any special-order speech shall be  
5 paid from the Members Representational Allowance of the  
6 Member making such speech.”.

1           (b) The amendment made by subsection (a) shall take  
2 effect on the first day beginning after the date of adoption  
3 of this resolution.
