Mr. SHOWS submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for the consideration of the bill (H.R. 3022) to provide for a program of temporary enhanced unemployment benefits.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall without intervention of any
3 point of order consider in the House the bill (H.R. 3022)
4 to provide for a program of temporary enhanced unem-
5 ployment benefits. The bill shall be considered as read for
6 amendment. An amendment in the nature of a substitute
7 consisting of the text of the Senate amendment to H.R.
8 3090 shall be considered as adopted. Points of order
9 against provisions of the bill, as amended, are waived. The
10 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the

1 bill, as amended, to final passage without intervening mo-
2 tion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill, as amended,
3 equally divided and controlled by the chairman and rank-
4 ing minority member of the Committee on Ways and
5 Means; and (2) one motion to recommit with or without
6 instructions.
