Mr. HASTINGS of Washington, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 275) expressing the sense of the Congress that hunting seasons for migratory mourning doves should be modified so that individuals have a fair and equitable opportunity to hunt such birds.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-

1 ation of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 275) ex-
2 pressing the sense of the Congress that hunting seasons
3 for migratory mourning doves should be modified so that
4 individuals have a fair and equitable opportunity to hunt
5 such birds. The first reading of the concurrent resolution
6 shall be dispensed with. All points of order against consid-
7 eration of the concurrent resolution are waived. General
8 debate shall be confined to the concurrent resolution and
9 shall not exceed one hour equally divided and controlled
10 by the chairman and ranking minority member of the
11 Committee on Resources. After general debate the concur-
12 rent resolution shall be considered for amendment under
13 the five-minute rule. The concurrent resolution shall be
14 considered as read. During consideration of the concurrent
15 resolution for amendment, the Chairman of the Committee
16 of the Whole may accord priority in recognition on the
17 basis of whether the Member offering an amendment has
18 caused it to be printed in the portion of the Congressional
19 Record designated for that purpose in clause 8 of rule
20 XVIII. Amendments so printed shall be considered as
21 read. At the conclusion of consideration of the concurrent
22 resolution for amendment the Committee shall rise and
23 report the concurrent resolution to the House with such
24 amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
25 question shall be considered as ordered on the concurrent

- 1 resolution and amendments thereto to final adoption with-
- 2 out intervening motion except one motion to recommit
- 3 with or without instructions.
