Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1       *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on  
2 the legislative day of Wednesday, March 6, 2002, for the  
3 Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the  
4 rules relating to the following measures:

5           (1) The joint resolution (S.J. Res. 32) con-  
6 gratulating the United States Military Academy at  
7 West Point on its bicentennial anniversary, and com-  
8 mending its outstanding contributions to the Nation.

1           (2) The bill (S. 1857) to encourage the nego-  
2           tiated settlement of tribal claims.

3           (3) The bill (H.R. 1870) to provide for the sale  
4           of certain real property within the Newlands Project  
5           in Nevada, to the city of Fallon, Nevada.

6           (4) The bill (H.R. 1883) to authorize the Sec-  
7           retary of the Interior to conduct a feasibility study  
8           on water optimization in the Burnt River basin,  
9           Malheur River basin, Owyhee River basin, and Pow-  
10          der River basin, Oregon.

11          (5) The bill (H.R. 1963) to amend the National  
12          Trails System Act to designate the route taken by  
13          American soldier and frontiersman George Rogers  
14          Clark and his men during the Revolutionary War to  
15          capture the British forts at Kaskaskia and Cahokia,  
16          Illinois, and Vincennes, Indiana, for study for poten-  
17          tial addition to the National Trails System.

18          (6) A bill to provide assistance to displaced  
19          workers by extending unemployment benefits and by  
20          providing a credit for health insurance costs, and for  
21          other purposes.

22          (7) A resolution expressing support for the  
23          democratically elected government of Colombia and  
24          its efforts to counter threats from United States-  
25          designated foreign terrorist organizations.
