RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the Senate amendment to the
bill (H.R. 3090) to provide tax incentives for economic
recovery.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to take from the Speaker's table the bill
3 (H.R. 3090) to provide tax incentives for economic recov-
4 ery, with the Senate amendment thereto, and to consider
5 in the House, without intervention of any point of order,
6 a motion offered by the chairman of the Committee on
7 Ways and Means or his designee that the House concur

1 in the Senate amendment with the amendment printed in
2 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
3 resolution. The Senate amendment and the motion shall
4 be considered as read. The motion shall be debatable for
5 one hour equally divided and controlled by the chairman
6 and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways
7 and Means. The previous question shall be considered as
8 ordered on the motion to final adoption without inter-
9 vening motion.
