## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 353) establishing the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2003 and setting forth appropriate budgetary levels for each of fiscal years 2004 through 2007.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the concurrent resolution (H. Con. Res. 353) es-

1 tablishing the congressional budget for the United States  
2 Government for fiscal year 2003 and setting forth appro-  
3 priate budgetary levels for each of fiscal years 2004  
4 through 2007. The first reading of the concurrent resolu-  
5 tion shall be dispensed with. All points of order against  
6 consideration of the concurrent resolution are waived.  
7 General debate shall not exceed three hours, with two  
8 hours of general debate confined to the congressional  
9 budget equally divided and controlled by the chairman and  
10 ranking minority member of the Committee on the Budg-  
11 et, and one hour of general debate on the subject of eco-  
12 nomic goals and policies equally divided and controlled by  
13 Representative Saxton of New Jersey and Representative  
14 Stark of California or their designees. The amendment in  
15 the nature of a substitute printed in the report of the  
16 Committee on Rules accompanying this resolution shall be  
17 considered as adopted in the House and in the Committee  
18 of the Whole. The concurrent resolution, as amended, shall  
19 be considered as read. After general debate the Committee  
20 shall rise and report the concurrent resolution, as amend-  
21 ed, to the House. The previous question shall be consid-  
22 ered as ordered on the concurrent resolution and amend-  
23 ments thereto to final adoption without intervening motion  
24 except amendments offered by the chairman of the Com-  
25 mittee on the Budget pursuant to section 305(a)(5) of the

1 Congressional Budget Act of 1974 to achieve mathe-  
2 matical consistency. The concurrent resolution shall not  
3 be subject to a demand for division of the question of its  
4 adoption.
