RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to apply the layover requirements for conference reports during the last six days of a session of Congress, to require that certain matter be included in joint explanatory statements accompanying conference reports, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That (a) clause 8(a) of rule XXII of the
2 Rules of the House of Representatives (relating to layover
3 requirements for conference reports) is amended by strik-
4 ing “(1) Except as specified in subparagraph (2), it” and
5 inserting “It” and by striking subparagraph (2).

1 (b) Clause 8(b) of rule XXII of the Rules of the
2 House of Representatives (relating to layover require-
3 ments for amendments in disagreement) is amended by
4 striking “(1) Except as specified in subparagraph (2), it”
5 and inserting “It” and by striking subparagraph (2).

6 (c) Clause 6(a)(2) of rule XIII of the Rules of the
7 House of Representatives (relating to privileged reports by
8 the Committee on Rules) is amended by striking “or of
9 clause 8”.

10 (d) Rule XXII of the Rules of the House of Rep-
11 resentatives (relating to House and Senate relations) is
12 amended by adding at the end the following new clause:

13 “13. It shall not be in order to consider a conference
14 report to accompany a bill or joint resolution making or
15 continuing appropriations unless—

16 “(1) the joint explanatory statement of the
17 managers includes a separate part that clearly sets
18 forth each item of appropriation added by the com-
19 mittee of conference to fund a new program, project,
20 or activity and the program, project, or activity to
21 which it relates; or

22 “(2) the chairman of the Committee on Appro-
23 priations causes such matter to be printed in the

- 1 Congressional Record before consideration of the
- 2 conference report.”.
