Mrs. MYRICK, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 2871) to reauthorize the Export-Import Bank of the United States, and for other purposes.

1       *Resolved*, That any time after the adoption of this res-  
2       olution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of rule  
3       XVIII, declare the House resolved into the committee of  
4       the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5       ation of the bill (H.R. 2871) to reauthorize the Export-  
6       Import Bank of the United States, and for other purposes.  
7       The first reading of the bill shall be dispensed with. All

1 points of order against consideration of the bill are waived.  
2 General debate shall be confined to the bill and shall not  
3 exceed one hour equally divided and controlled by the  
4 chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee  
5 on Financial Services. After general debate the bill shall  
6 be considered for amendment under the five-minute rule.  
7 It shall be in order to consider as an original bill for the  
8 purpose of amendment under the five-minute rule the  
9 amendment in the nature of a substitute recommended by  
10 the Committee on Financial Services now printed in the  
11 bill. The committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
12 stitute shall be considered as read. All points of order  
13 against the committee amendment in the nature of a sub-  
14 stitute are waived. No amendment to the committee  
15 amendment in the nature of a substitute shall be in order  
16 except those printed in the report of the Committee on  
17 Rules accompanying this resolution. Each such amend-  
18 ment may be offered only in the order printed in the re-  
19 port, may be offered only by a Member designated in the  
20 report, shall be considered as read, shall be debatable for  
21 the time specified in the report equally divided and con-  
22 trolled by the proponent and an opponent, shall not be  
23 subject to amendment, and shall not be subject to a de-  
24 mand for division of the question in the House or in the  
25 Committee of the Whole. All points of order against such

1 amendments are waived. At the conclusion of consider-  
2 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
3 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
4 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a  
5 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
6 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-  
7 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-  
8 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill  
9 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-  
10 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or  
11 without instructions.

12       SEC. 2. After passage of H.R. 2871, it shall be in  
13 order to take from the Speaker's table S. 1372 and to  
14 consider the Senate bill in the House. All points of order  
15 against the Senate bill and against its consideration are  
16 waived. It shall be in order to move to strike all after the  
17 enacting clause of the Senate bill and to insert in lieu  
18 thereof the provisions of H.R. 2871 as passed by the  
19 House. All points of order against that motion are waived.  
20 If the motion is adopted and the Senate bill, as amended,  
21 is passed, then it shall be in order to move that the House  
22 insist on its amendment to S. 1372 and request a con-  
23 ference with the Senate thereon.
