RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4019) to provide that the marriage penalty relief provisions of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall be permanent.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 4019) to provide that the marriage penalty relief provi-
4 sions of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconcili-
5 ation Act of 2001 shall be permanent. The bill shall be

1 considered as read for amendment. The previous question
2 shall be considered as ordered on the bill and on any
3 amendment thereto to final passage without intervening
4 motion except: (1) one hour of debate on the bill equally
5 divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
6 nority member of the Committee on Ways and Means; (2)
7 the amendment in the nature of a substitute printed in
8 the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying this
9 resolution, if offered by Representative Rangel of New
10 York or his designee, which shall be in order without inter-
11 vention of any point of order, shall be considered as read,
12 and shall be separately debatable for one hour equally di-
13 vided and controlled by the proponent and an opponent;
14 and (3) one motion to recommit with or without instruc-
15 tions.
