RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4931) to provide that the pension and individual retirement arrangement provisions of the Economic Growth and Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall be permanent.

1 *Resolved*, That upon the adoption of this resolution
2 it shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 4931) to provide that the pension and individual retire-
4 ment arrangement provisions of the Economic Growth and
5 Tax Relief Reconciliation Act of 2001 shall be permanent.
6 The bill shall be considered as read for amendment. The

1 previous question shall be considered as ordered on the
2 bill and on any amendment thereto to final passage with-
3 out intervening motion except: (1) One hour of debate on
4 the bill equally divided and controlled by the chairman and
5 ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and
6 Means; (2) the amendment in the nature of a substitute
7 printed in the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
8 panying this resolution, if offered by Representative Mat-
9 sui of California or his designee, which shall be in order
10 without intervention of any point of order, shall be consid-
11 ered as read, and shall be separately debatable for one
12 hour equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
13 an opponent; and (3) one motion to recommit with or
14 without instructions.
