Mr. SESSIONS, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 333) to amend title 11, United States Code, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 333) to amend title 11, United
6 States Code, and for other purposes. The first reading of
7 the bill shall be dispensed with. All points of order against
8 consideration of the bill are waived. General debate shall

1 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour equal-
2 ly divided and controlled by the chairman and ranking mi-
3 nority member of the Committee on the Judiciary. After
4 general debate the bill shall be considered for amendment
5 under the five-minute rule. The amendments rec-
6 ommended by the Committee on the Judiciary now printed
7 in the bill shall be considered as adopted in the House
8 and in the Committee of the Whole. The bill, as amended,
9 shall be considered as the original bill for the purpose of
10 further amendment under the five-minute rule and shall
11 be considered as read. All points of order against provi-
12 sions in the bill, as amended, are waived. No further
13 amendment to the bill shall be in order except those print-
14 ed in the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
15 this resolution. Each such amendment may be offered only
16 in the order printed in the report, may be offered only
17 by a Member designated in the report, shall be considered
18 as read, shall be debatable for the time specified in the
19 report equally divided and controlled by the proponent and
20 an opponent, shall not be subject to amendment, and shall
21 not be subject to a demand for division of the question
22 in the House or in the Committee of the Whole. All points
23 of order against such amendments are waived. At the con-
24 clusion of consideration of the bill for amendment the
25 Committee shall rise and report the bill, as amended, to

1 the House with such further amendments as may have
2 been adopted. The previous question shall be considered
3 as ordered on the bill and amendments thereto to final
4 passage without intervening motion except one motion to
5 recommit with or without instructions.

6 SEC. 2. Upon receipt of a message from the Senate
7 transmitting H.R. 333 with Senate amendments thereto,
8 it shall be in order to consider in the House a motion of-
9 fered by the chairman of the Committee on the Judiciary
10 or his designee that the House disagree to the Senate
11 amendments and request or agree to a conference with
12 the Senate thereon.
