CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Permitting the remains of the Honorable John Lewis, late a Representative from the State of Georgia, to lie in state in the rotunda of the Capitol.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring)*, That in recognition of the long and distin-
3 guished service rendered to the Nation by the Honorable
4 John Lewis, late a Representative from the State of Geor-
5 gia, his remains shall be permitted to lie in state in the
6 Rotunda of the Capitol from July 27, 2020, through July
7 29, 2020, and the Architect of the Capitol,

1 under the direction of the President pro tempore of the
2 Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives,
3 shall take all necessary steps for the accomplishment of
4 that purpose.
