JOINT RESOLUTION

Providing for congressional disapproval of the proposed foreign military sale to the United Arab Emirates of certain defense articles and services.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That the following proposed foreign military sale to the
4 United Arab Emirates is prohibited:

5 (1) The sale of the following defense articles,
6 including defense services and technical data, de-
7 scribed in Transmittal No. 21–01, submitted to Con-
8 gress pursuant to section 36(b) of the Arms Export
9 Control Act (22 U.S.C. 2776(b)) and published in
10 the Congressional Record on November 10, 2020:

1 Fifty (50) F-35A Joint Strike Fighter Conventional
2 Take-Off and Landing (CTOL) Aircraft; Fifty-four
3 (54) Pratt & Whitney F-135 Engines (up to 50 in-
4 stalled and 4 spares); Electronic Warfare Systems;
5 Command, Control, Communications, Computer and
6 Intelligence/Communications, Navigational, and
7 Identification (C4I/CNI); Autonomic Logistics Glob-
8 al Support System (ALGS); Operational Data Inte-
9 grated Network (ODIN); Air System Training De-
10 vices; Weapons Employment Capability and other
11 Subsystems, Features, and Capabilities; F-35
12 unique chaff and infrared flares; reprogramming
13 center access; F-35 Performance Based Logistics;
14 software development/integration; aircraft ferry and
15 tanker support; aircraft and munitions support and
16 test equipment; communications equipment; provi-
17 sioning, spares, and repair parts; weapons repair
18 and return support; personnel training and training
19 equipment; weapon systems software, publications,
20 and technical documents; United States Government
21 and contractor engineering, technical, and logistics
22 support services; and other related elements of
23 logistical and program support.
