JOINT RESOLUTION

Redesignating the Robert E. Lee Memorial in Arlington
National Cemetery as the “Arlington House”.

1 *Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives*
2 *of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*
3 That—

4 (1) the house in Arlington National Cemetery
5 dedicated as a memorial to Robert E. Lee pursuant
6 to the joint resolution of June 29, 1955 (Public Law
7 84–107; 69 Stat. 190), shall after the date of the

1 enactment of this joint resolution be redesignated
2 and known as the “Arlington House”; and

3 (2) any reference in any law, regulation, map,
4 document, paper, or other record of the United
5 States to the house referred to in paragraph (1)
6 shall be considered to be a reference to the Arlington
7 House.
