## AN ACT

To amend title XXIX of the Public Health Service Act to reauthorize the program under such title relating to lifespan respite care.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Lifespan Respite Care  
3 Reauthorization Act of 2019”.

4 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF LIFESPAN RESPITE CARE**  
5 **PROGRAM.**

6 (a) **DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.**—Section  
7 2904 of the Public Health Service Act (42 U.S.C. 290ii–  
8 3) is amended to read as follows:

9 **“SEC. 2904. DATA COLLECTION AND REPORTING.**

10 “Each eligible State agency awarded a grant or coop-  
11 erative agreement under section 2902 shall collect, main-  
12 tain, and report such data and records at such times, in  
13 such form, and in such manner as the Secretary may re-  
14 quire to enable the Secretary—

15 “(1) to monitor State administration of pro-  
16 grams and activities funded pursuant to such grant  
17 or cooperative agreement; and

18 “(2) to evaluate, and to compare effectiveness  
19 on a State-by-State basis, of programs and activities  
20 funded pursuant to section 2902.”.

21 (b) **FUNDING.**—Section 2905 of the Public Health  
22 Service Act (42 U.S.C. 300ii–4) is amended by striking  
23 paragraphs (1) through (5) and inserting the following:

24 “(1) \$20,000,000 for fiscal year 2020;

25 “(2) \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2021;

26 “(3) \$40,000,000 for fiscal year 2022;

- 1           “(4) \$50,000,000 for fiscal year 2023; and
- 2           “(5) \$60,000,000 for fiscal year 2024.”.
