Mr. GREEN of Texas (for himself, Mr. HUIZENGA, and Mrs. CAROLYN B.
MALONEY of New York) introduced the following bill; which was referred
to the Committee on Financial Services

A BILL

To amend the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934 to
amend the definition of whistleblower.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WHISTLEBLOWER.**

4 Section 21F(a)(6) of the Securities Exchange Act of
5 1934 (15 U.S.C. 78u–6(a)(6)) is amended—

6 (1) by striking “(6) WHISTLEBLOWER.—The
7 term” and inserting the following:

8 “(6) WHISTLEBLOWER.—

9 “(A) IN GENERAL.—The term”; and

1 (2) by adding at the end the following new sub-
2 paragraph:

3 “(B) SPECIAL RULE.—Solely for the pur-
4 poses of subsection (h), the term ‘whistleblower’
5 shall also include any individual who takes an
6 action described in subsection (h)(1)(A), or two
7 or more individuals acting jointly who take an
8 action described in subsection (h)(1)(A).”.

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
