A BILL

To amend the National Wildlife Refuge System Administration Act of 1966 to prohibit the use of neonicotinoids in a National Wildlife Refuge, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protect Our Refuges
5 Act of 2019”.

1 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITION OF THE USE OF NEONICOTINOIDS IN**
2 **A NATIONAL WILDLIFE REFUGE.**

3 The National Wildlife Refuge System Administration
4 Act of 1966 (16 U.S.C. 668dd et seq.) is amended—

5 (1) by redesignating section 5 as section 6; and

6 (2) by inserting after section 4 the following:

7 **“SEC. 5 NEONICOTINOID.**

8 “No person may use a neonicotinoid in the System.”.

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
