AN ACT

To authorize the Secretary of the Interior to correct a land ownership error within the boundary of Rocky Mountain National Park, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Rocky Mountain Na-
3 tional Park Ownership Correction Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DEFINITIONS.**

5 In this Act:

6 (1) **FEDERAL LAND.**—The term “Federal land”
7 means the approximately 0.18 acres of land depicted
8 as “TR04–168–1” on the map.

9 (2) **MAP.**—The term “map” means the map en-
10 titled “Rocky Mountain National Park Proposed
11 Forsyth Family Land Exchange”, numbered 121/
12 154,326, and dated June 2019.

13 (3) **NON-FEDERAL LAND.**—The term “non-Fed-
14 eral land” means the approximately 0.18 acres of
15 land depicted as “TR04–169” on the map.

16 (4) **SECRETARY.**—The term “Secretary” means
17 the Secretary of the Interior.

18 **SEC. 3. ROCKY MOUNTAIN NATIONAL PARK LAND EX-**
19 **CHANGE.**

20 (a) **AUTHORIZATION OF EXCHANGE.**—To correct a
21 longstanding land ownership error, if the owner of the
22 non-Federal land offers to convey to the Secretary all
23 right, title, and interest of the owner in and to the non-
24 Federal land, the Secretary shall convey to the owner of
25 the non-Federal land, subject to valid existing rights, all

1 right, title, and interest of the United States in and to
2 the Federal land.

3 (b) VALUATION.—The value of the Federal land and
4 the non-Federal land to be exchanged under this Act shall
5 be considered to be of equal value.

6 (c) ADMINISTRATION.—The non-Federal land ac-
7 quired by the Secretary under this section shall be admin-
8 istered by the Secretary as part of Rocky Mountain Na-
9 tional Park.

10 (d) AVAILABILITY OF MAP.—The map shall be on file
11 and available for inspection in the appropriate offices of
12 the National Park Service.
