A BILL

To designate a peak in the State of Washington as
“qʷəłtmáyq̓n-ʔistiqaʔ-Mount Cleator”.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF qʷəłtmáyq̓n-ʔistiqaʔ-MOUNT**

4 **CLEATOR IN THE STATE OF WASHINGTON.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The 7,630-foot peak located at
6 latitude 48.11516° N, longitude 120.94636° W, in the
7 Glacier Peak Wilderness in the State of Washington, shall
8 be known and designated as “qʷəłtmáyq̓n-ʔistiqaʔ-
9 Mount Cleator”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the peak referred to in subsection (a) shall be
4 deemed to be a reference to q^wəłtmáyqn-łistiqayu?-Mount
5 Cleator.
