CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Authorizing the use of the Capitol Grounds for the National Peace Officers Memorial Service and the National Honor Guard and Pipe Band Exhibition.

1 *Resolved by the House of Representatives (the Senate*
2 *concurring),*

3 **SECTION 1. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NA-**
4 **TIONAL PEACE OFFICERS MEMORIAL SERV-**
5 **ICE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-
7 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary shall be

1 permitted to sponsor a public event, the 41st Annual Na-
2 tional Peace Officers Memorial Service (in this resolution
3 referred to as the “Memorial Service”), on the Capitol
4 Grounds, in order to honor the law enforcement officers
5 who died in the line of duty during 2021.

6 (b) DATE OF MEMORIAL SERVICE.—The Memorial
7 Service shall be held on May 15, 2022, or on such other
8 date as the Speaker of the House of Representatives and
9 the Committee on Rules and Administration of the Senate
10 jointly designate, with preparation for the event to begin
11 on May 10, 2022, and takedown completed on May 16,
12 2022.

13 **SEC. 2. USE OF THE CAPITOL GROUNDS FOR NATIONAL**
14 **HONOR GUARD AND PIPE BAND EXHIBITION.**

15 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Grand Lodge of the Fra-
16 ternal Order of Police and its auxiliary shall be permitted
17 to sponsor a public event, the National Honor Guard and
18 Pipe Band Exhibition (in this resolution referred to as the
19 “Exhibition”), on the Capitol Grounds, in order to allow
20 law enforcement representatives to exhibit their ability to
21 demonstrate Honor Guard programs and provide for a
22 bagpipe exhibition.

23 (b) DATE OF EXHIBITION.—The Exhibition shall be
24 held on May 14, 2022, or on such other date as the Speak-

1 er of the House of Representatives and the Committee on
2 Rules and Administration of the Senate jointly designate.

3 **SEC. 3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Under conditions to be prescribed
5 by the Architect of the Capitol and the Capitol Police
6 Board, the event shall be—

7 (1) free of admission charge and open to the
8 public; and

9 (2) arranged not to interfere with the needs of
10 Congress.

11 (b) EXPENSES AND LIABILITIES.—The sponsors of
12 the Memorial Service and Exhibition shall assume full re-
13 sponsibility for all expenses and liabilities incident to all
14 activities associated with the events.

15 **SEC. 4. EVENT PREPARATIONS.**

16 Subject to the approval of the Architect of the Cap-
17 itol, the sponsors referred to in section 3(b) are authorized
18 to erect upon the Capitol Grounds such stage, sound am-
19 plification devices, and other related structures and equip-
20 ment, as may be required for the Memorial Service and
21 Exhibition.

22 **SEC. 5. ENFORCEMENT OF RESTRICTIONS.**

23 The Capitol Police Board shall provide for enforce-
24 ment of the restrictions contained in section 5104(c) of
25 title 40, United States Code, concerning sales, advertise-
