AN ACT

For the relief of Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, and
Vandana Kurdekar.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. PERMANENT RESIDENT STATUS FOR ARPITA**
2 **KURDEKAR, GIRISH KURDEKAR, AND**
3 **VANDANA KURDEKAR.**

4 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding subsections (a)
5 and (b) of section 201 of the Immigration and Nationality
6 Act, Arpita Kurdekar, Girish Kurdekar, and Vandana
7 Kurdekar shall each be eligible for issuance of an immi-
8 grant visa or for adjustment of status to that of an alien
9 lawfully admitted for permanent residence upon filing an
10 application for issuance of an immigrant visa under sec-
11 tion 204 of such Act or for adjustment of status to lawful
12 permanent resident.

13 (b) ADJUSTMENT OF STATUS.—If Arpita Kurdekar,
14 Girish Kurdekar, or Vandana Kurdekar enters the United
15 States before the filing deadline specified in subsection (c),
16 he or she shall be considered to have entered and remained
17 lawfully and shall, if otherwise eligible, be eligible for ad-
18 justment of status under section 245 of the Immigration
19 and Nationality Act as of the date of the enactment of
20 this Act.

21 (c) DEADLINE FOR APPLICATION AND PAYMENT OF
22 FEES.—Subsections (a) and (b) shall apply only if the ap-
23 plication for issuance of an immigrant visa or the applica-
24 tion for adjustment of status is filed with appropriate fees
25 within 2 years after the date of the enactment of this Act.
