RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 263) to amend the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 to clarify provisions enacted by the Captive Wildlife Safety Act, to further the conservation of certain wildlife species, and for other purposes, and providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 4040) to amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend telehealth flexibilities under the Medicare program, and for other purposes.

1 *Resolved*, That upon adoption of this resolution it
2 shall be in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R.
3 263) to amend the Lacey Act Amendments of 1981 to
4 clarify provisions enacted by the Captive Wildlife Safety
5 Act, to further the conservation of certain wildlife species,
6 and for other purposes. All points of order against consid-
7 eration of the bill are waived. The amendment in the na-
8 ture of a substitute recommended by the Committee on
9 Natural Resources now printed in the bill shall be consid-
10 ered as adopted. The bill, as amended, shall be considered
11 as read. All points of order against provisions in the bill,
12 as amended, are waived. The previous question shall be
13 considered as ordered on the bill, as amended, and on any
14 further amendment thereto, to final passage without inter-
15 vening motion except: (1) one hour of debate equally di-
16 vided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority
17 member of the Committee on Natural Resources or their
18 respective designees; (2) the further amendment printed
19 in part A of the report of the Committee on Rules accom-
20 panying this resolution, if offered by the Member des-
21 igned in the report, which shall be in order without
22 intervention of any point of order, shall be considered as
23 read, shall be separately debatable for the time specified
24 in the report equally divided and controlled by the pro-
25 ponent and an opponent, and shall not be subject to a

1 demand for division of the question; and (3) one motion
2 to recommit.

3 SEC. 2. Upon adoption of this resolution it shall be
4 in order to consider in the House the bill (H.R. 4040)
5 to amend title XVIII of the Social Security Act to extend
6 telehealth flexibilities under the Medicare program, and
7 for other purposes. All points of order against consider-
8 ation of the bill are waived. An amendment in the nature
9 of a substitute consisting of the text of Rules Committee
10 Print 117–59, modified by the amendment printed in part
11 B of the report of the Committee on Rules accompanying
12 this resolution, shall be considered as adopted. The bill,
13 as amended, shall be considered as read. All points of
14 order against provisions in the bill, as amended, are
15 waived. The previous question shall be considered as or-
16 dered on the bill, as amended, and on any further amend-
17 ment thereto, to final passage without intervening motion
18 except: (1) one hour of debate equally divided and con-
19 trolled by the chair and ranking minority member of the
20 Committee on Energy and Commerce or their respective
21 designees; and (2) one motion to recommit.
