A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Corner Post Reversal
5 Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. RIGHT OF REVIEW.**

2 Section 702 of title 5, United States Code, is amend-
3 ed by inserting “Except as otherwise expressly provided
4 by law, an action under this section shall be commenced
5 within 6 years after the date on which the relevant agency
6 action was finalized.” after “judicial review thereof.”.
