A BILL

To provide for citizen engagement on the development and adoption of Federal civilian agency use of artificial intelligence, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CITIZEN ENGAGEMENT ON DEVELOPMENT AND**
4 **ADOPTION OF FEDERAL CIVILIAN AGENCY**
5 **USE OF ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Secu-
7 rity shall conduct virtual and in-person listening sessions
8 in various locations in the United States to provide a

1 forum for discussion and consultation with appropriate
2 representatives of States, territories, Tribal authorities,
3 civil rights organizations, human rights organizations,
4 women’s rights organizations, immigrant communities,
5 faith communities, environmental protection organiza-
6 tions, agricultural businesses (including family and spe-
7 cially farming and ranching entities), labor organizations,
8 and academia regarding the development and adoption of
9 Federal civilian agency use of artificial intelligence.

10 (b) FURTHER ENGAGEMENT.—The Secretary of
11 Homeland Security shall encourage entities described in
12 subsection (a) to conduct listening sessions similar to
13 those described in such subsection, and report back to the
14 Secretary regarding development and adoption of Federal
15 civilian agency use of artificial intelligence.

16 (c) REPORT.—Not later than 240 days after the date
17 of the enactment of this Act and annually thereafter, the
18 Secretary of Homeland Security shall submit to Congress
19 a report on the attitudes, opinions, and beliefs of the
20 American public regarding development and adoption of
21 Federal civilian agency use of artificial intelligence.
