AN ACT

To amend the Legislative Reorganization Act of 1970 to authorize the Legislative Counsel of the House of Representatives to designate more than one of the attorneys of the Office of the Legislative Counsel as a Deputy Legislative Counsel, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “House Office of Legis-
3 lative Counsel Modernization Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. DESIGNATION OF MULTIPLE DEPUTY LEGISLATIVE**
5 **COUNSELS.**

6 (a) DESIGNATION.—Section 522(b)(1) of the Legisla-
7 tive Reorganization Act of 1970 (2 U.S.C. 282a(b)(1)) is
8 amended—

9 (1) by amending the first sentence to read as
10 follows: “The Legislative Counsel shall designate one
11 or more of the attorneys appointed under subsection
12 (a) as a Deputy Legislative Counsel.”; and

13 (2) in the second sentence, by striking “the
14 Deputy Legislative Counsel shall perform the func-
15 tions of the Legislative Counsel.” and inserting “the
16 functions of the Legislative Counsel shall be per-
17 formed by a Deputy Legislative Counsel. If there is
18 more than one Deputy Legislative Counsel, the Dep-
19 uty Legislative Counsel who shall perform such func-
20 tions shall be determined in accordance with the
21 order specified in a notice filed with the Speaker and
22 the Minority Leader of the House by the Legislative
23 Counsel.”.

24 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 522(b)(2)
25 of such Act (2 U.S.C. 282a(b)(2)) is amended by striking

- 1 “Deputy Legislative Counsel” and inserting “Deputy Leg-
- 2 islative Counsels”.
