2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. CLASS A MISDEMEANOR.**

4 Section 3559 of title 18, United States Code, is
5 amended by adding at the end the following:

6 “(h) CLASS A MISDEMEANOR.—Any person who will-
7 fully and knowingly violates a provision of Federal law,

- 1 for which no punishment is prescribed for such violation
- 2 under statute, shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor.”.
