WEEKLY SUMMARY

Sgt. A. E. LEONARD, Intelligence Division, Dade County Department of Public Safety, Miami, Fla., on 7/12/62 advised he had received information that JOSEPH FISCHETTI (Miami File 92-99) is now associated with the Deauville Hotel, Miami Beach, Fla., presumably as a theatrical booking agent.

MM 665-C on 7/3/62 advised that MORRIS LANSBURG, principal owner of the Flamingo Hotel, Las Vegas, Nevada, as well as the Deauville Hotel, mentioned above, and other Miami Beach hotels, furnished an all-expense tour and flight from Miami to Las Vegas shortly after the middle of June, 1962 and that JOE FISCHETTI was on this flight to Las Vegas.

JACK MILLER, Manager, Voyager Motel, North Miami, advised on 7/8/62 that GILBERT BECKLEY (Miami File 92-353) left on 7/8/62 and said he was going to California. Records of National Airlines reflect that BECKLEY left on 7/8/62 for Vancouver via Los Angeles and Seattle on the return portion of the ticket purchased on 4/11/62 at Vancouver.

RICHARD JAFFE, Special Agent, Internal Revenue Service, Miami, Fla., on 7/9/62 advised that on 7/8/62 he

MM 509-C on 7/10/62 advised that he received information concerning a number of "hoodlums" at Miami Beach who in the near future will have an interest in a gambling casino, presently being constructed on one of the islands in the Caribbean area. So far he has received information that WILLIAM GUSTAV BISCHOFF (Miami File 92-89) will have a piece of it; that JOSEPH MASSEI (Miami File 92-122) will bankroll BISCHOFF or have a piece of it; that GEORGE GORDON (Miami File 92-458) and his associates will have a large portion of same and that possibly MAX EDER (Miami File 92-467) and PASQUALE ERRA (Miami File 92-648) will have a portion of the operation as they took part in a discussion of same with BISCHOFF and GORDON at the Bayshore Golf Club, Miami Beach, on 7/7/62.
