DREW accompanied by his wife and small child arrived in New Orleans by Delta Airlines, 1/14/62, and stayed at the Roosevelt Hotel in New Orleans in a complimentary suite. Departed 9:35 a.m., 1/16/62 en route to Montego Bay, Jamaica. He did not have plane reservations but had tickets apparently routing him through Miami on return trip. No activities noted on the part of DREW at New Orleans. DREW known to Roosevelt Hotel officials as prominent hotel operator in Las Vegas. Appropriate offices advised.

GAMBLING, VICKSBURG, MISSISSIPPI

New Orleans airtel, 1/12/62, furnished information regarding the current gambling situation on the Mississippi Gulf Coast. Enclosed herewith is a letterhead memorandum reflecting the current gambling situation at Vicksburg, Mississippi, and Warren County, Mississippi.
