

It is noted that on 6/29/61 agents of IRS, Pittsburgh, took part in what the press alleged was a nationwide series of raids on gamblers. Local IRS agents concentrated their raids at about 2:00 PM in the Turtle Creek Valley section of Allegheny County, about 10 miles East of Pittsburgh, apprehending some 25 small numbers operators.

On 7/6/61, PG 612-C advised SA THOMAS G. FORSYTH, III:

The MANNARINOS knew of the impending raids by IRS agents at 9:30 AM on 6/29/61, several hours before the raids occurred. This information was relayed quickly to all numbers writing and/or horse bookies who turn in to the MANNARINOS throughout the New Kensington-Arnold-Vandergrift, Pa., area. Apparently the MANNARINOS did not know where the IRS agents would raid, merely that raids would come off.
