SUBJECT: ANGELO BRUNO  
ANTI-RACKETEERING

Bruno is the "commission" member of La Cosa Nostra in the Philadelphia area. He has been utilizing the automobile of our top echelon informant, PH 614-C-TE, for trips averaging 200 to 300 miles. According to our informant, Bruno is converting his assets into currency of large denominations and contemplates leaving for Italy, probably in October of 1964. The extent of his stay in Italy is not known. It is believed that Bruno is also meeting with other "commission" leaders on the trips he is taking with the informant's automobile.

SAC Jamieson of the Philadelphia Office called on the morning of September 17, 1964, and requested permission to install a CAT transmitter in the informant's automobile, which will enable the Philadelphia Office to cover Bruno's conversation while in the informant's car. According to Jamieson, Philadelphia has an opportunity today to make this installation with complete security and without the knowledge of the informant. He pointed out that informant is leaving for the Dominican Republic this weekend and Bruno will have exclusive access to the informant's car during the two weeks that the informant will be in the Dominican Republic.

### ACTION

SAC Jamieson was informed that unless advised to the contrary by close of business today he should proceed with the installation. Sound trained personnel of the New York Office, who are knowledgeable in the technique of making this installation, are available to the Philadelphia Office. In view of the importance of Bruno in La Cosa Nostra and the recent developments which indicate he is meeting with important members of this organization and converting his assets, it is recommended that the present opportunity to make this installation be utilized.
