

ON SEPTEMBER 4 LAST BUREAU ADVISED THAT SOURCE, HALF MOON INN, SAN DIEGO REPORTED ROSSELLI HAD RESERVATIONS AT VACATION VILLAGE, SAN DIEGO FOR LABOR DAY WEEKEND. SAN DIEGO ADVISED TODAY RECHECK WITH SOURCE DISCLOSED RESERVATION FOR MAURICE H. FRIEDMAN AND NOT ROSSELLI.

LA 4268-C ADVISED TODAY THAT ON SEPTEMBER 7 LAST MAURICE H. FRIEDMAN MADE TELEPHONE CALL TO LOUIS J. LEDERER IN CHICAGO BUT LEDERER NO AT NUMBER CALLED AND OPERATOR TO CALL BACK IF LEDERER LOCATED. SOURCE DOES NOT KNOW IF CALL COMPLETED. IRS, LOS ANGELES
