Re New York airtel to Bureau, 3/7/69, and Miami teletypes to Bureau, 2/28/69, and 3/1/69, entitled "POSSIBLE TRAVEL OF KANSAS CITY HOODLUM FIGURES TO HOLLYWOOD, FLORIDA, ON OR ABOUT 3/1/69; AR."

For the information of New York, a group of individuals from Kansas City has annually, about this time of the year, traveled to New Orleans, Louisiana, and Ocean Springs, Mississippi, for approximately one week for the purpose of a vacation and to play golf. Because of FBI investigations and surveillances in the Mississippi and Louisiana areas, this group apparently changed their destination this year to Hollywood, Florida.

According to KC 358-C-TE, the purpose of the trip this year, as in the past, was for the purpose of playing golf, to gamble and meet with friends. These individuals had reservations at the Hollywood Beach Hotel, Hollywood, Florida.

Four of the individuals who made this trip have previously been identified as LCN members and are as follows:

The other persons were associates of the above.

The 14 individuals left Kansas City 3/1/69, via TWA and arrived Miami, Florida, the same date. Departmental Task Force, Miami, was aware of [redacted] and served [redacted] with subpoenas to appear before the Federal Grand Jury, 3/4/69. Subpoenas were served by members of the Task Force and local law enforcement officials. The FBI did not participate.
