~~CG 6443-C~~ advised that ~~DICK BERNAS~~, who is an associate of LESLIE CRUSE and who does remodeling and architectural work for CRUSE and other individuals of organized crime in the Chicago area, resides in a home at the rear of LESLIE CRUSE's home on the same property. He stated that BERNAS pays a monthly rent to CRUSE for the use of this home. He stated that in one of the rooms of BERNAS' home there is a safe located in the floor adjacent to a wall in which CRUSE stores much of his currency. In addition, he advised that the garage attached to BERNAS' home is adjacent to the garage used by CRUSE to the rear of CRUSE's home and that an underground passage connects both garages. He advised that many times stolen merchandise is stored in the garage used by BERNAS. U
