


NOTE ON YELLOW: [The CIA in Miami has advised that although Capo is under assessment for operational interest in connection with the operation of a clandestine radio network, he is not yet under CIA control and "should be stopped." The Border Patrol plans to allow the PT boat to make the reconnaissance trip but will stop the expedition involving the Americans. This communication being classified "Confidential" inasmuch as information contained herein was furnished by MM 639-S (u) informant of continuing value, disclosure of which information could adversely affect the future effectiveness of this informant. ANTI-COMMUNIST LEGIONNAIRES, NM. RE MM LETTER MAY 11 LAST WITH ENCLOSURES. EMM 639-S ON MAY 17 INSTANT, ADVISED THAT GERALD PATRICK HENNING, HEAD OF CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION, HAS BEEN IN CONTACT WITH AGUSTIN CAPO, CUBAN NATIONAL IN MM, WHO HAS ACCESS TO A PT BOAT AND A QUANTITY OF RADIO EQUIPMENT. CAPO PLANS TO MAKE A RECONNAISSANCE TRIP TO CAY AGUILLA, CAY SAL BANK, BRITISH ISLANDS NORTH OF CUBA, ON MAY 17 INSTANT. CAPO WILL RETURN TO MM AND ON MAY 26 WILL RETURN TO CAY AGUILLA BY SAME PT BOAT AND WILL TAKE WITH HIM HENNING AND 15-20 AMERICANS WHO ARE MEMBERS OF CAPTIONED ORGANIZATION. INFORMANT EXPECTS HENNING AND GROUP WILL HAVE ARMS AND WILL TRY TO OPERATE OUT OF CAY AGUILLA AGAINST CUBA ON COMMANDO RAIDS. CIA, MM ADVISED ALTHOUGH CAPO IS UNDER ASSESSMENT FOR OPERATIONAL INTEREST IN CONNECTION WITH THE OPERATION OF A CLANDESTINE RADIO NETWORK, HE IS NOT YET UNDER CIA CONTROL AND SHOULD BE STOPPED. US BORDER PATROL AND CUSTOMS ADVISED. BORDER PATROL PLANS TO ALLOW PT BOAT TO MAKE RECONNAISSANCE TRIP BUT WILL STOP THE EXPEDITION INVOLVING THE AMERICANS. EMM 639-S EXPECTS TO BE ABLE TO FURNISH FULL DETAILS OF BOAT TRIPS INASMUCH AS OTHER AGENCIES APPARENTLY HAVE NO COVERAGE. BUREAU WILL BE KEPT ADVISED. LETTERHEAD MEMO FOLLOWS.
