


DAILY SUMMARY. JUNE. CG 6533-C ADVISED INSTANT THAT A LARGE GATHERING OF PERSONS WERE OBSERVED AT THE ARMORY LOUNGE DURING THE NIGHT OF AUGUST 28 LAST, AMONG WHOM INFORMANT RECOGNIZED DOMINIC BLASI, AND POSSIBLY GIANCANA. (U)

CG 6486-C\* ADVISED DURING LATE EVENING HOURS AUGUST 28 LAST, SEVERAL INDIVIDUALS WERE CONVERSING ABOUT GENERAL MATTERS. NAMES OF ACCARDO AND "MOE" WERE MENTIONED, HOWEVER, NOTHING PERTINENT OBTAINED. INFORMANT UNCERTAIN AS TO WHETHER OR NOT GIANCANA WAS PRESENT. (U)

NOTED THAT CG 6486-C\* EXPERIENCING TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES WHICH SHOULD BE RESOLVED SHORTLY. DIFFICULTIES APPEAR TO BE UNDER CONTROL OF TELEPHONE COMPANY AND NOT CONSIDERED TO BE OF JEOPARDY TO SOURCE. (U)
