INFORMATION CONCERNING

Enclosed for the Bureau is the original and three copies of a LHM regarding Judge HAGGERTY.

On 1/5/70, ROBERT LECORGNE, the Judicial Administrative Officer of the State of Louisiana, telephonically contacted ASAC J. T. SYLVESTER, JR., and advised that he, LECORGNE, was a chief investigator for the Louisiana Judiciary Commission and that he is currently investigating Judge HAGGERTY with reference to Judge HAGGERTY's being charged along with 13 other persons as a result of a vice raid and LECORGNE was inquiring regarding any FBI information on Judge HAGGERTY. LECORGNE was advised by ASAC SYLVESTER of the confidential nature of the records of the FBI and that LECORGNE should not infer in this connection either that the FBI does or does not have information in its files relating to the subject of his inquiry.

The information following and the enclosed LHM are being furnished to the Bureau for information as it is anticipated that LECORGNE may request this information through the Attorney General's Office.

New Orleans indices do not contain any information of value on ROBERT LECORGNE.

For the Bureau's information, the Louisiana Judiciary Commission was newly established in 1968 as a part of the Louisiana Constitution, Article 9, Section 4, which provides for the make-up of the commission to consist of one Judge of the Court of Appeals, three judges of courts of record selected by the Supreme Court, two members of the Louisiana Bar Association, who have practiced in Louisiana, for ten years, and one citizen, and provides that the Judicial Administrator is the chief executive of the Judicial Commission. The Judicial Commission's proceedings are confidential and their job is to investigate and hold hearings to remove any judge guilty of wilful misconduct relating to his official duties, habitual intemperance or conviction while in office of a felony.

New Orleans indices contain numerous references in which the opinions of Judge HAGGERTY are noted throughout the trial of CLAY SHAW for conspiracy in the death of President KENNEDY.
