Re: HOFFA Trial

On 1/29/64, NY 2305-C advised that while in Washington, D.C., he had spoken to DAN MAHER concerning HOFFA's current trial. MAHER told him that in his opinion, the government has already committed several reversible errors and has given the defense good grounds on which to appeal.

Re: HAROLD GIBBONS

Source advised that HAROLD GIBBONS is going on the payroll of the Teamsters International Union as a Vice President. He said that LARRY STEINBERG is still on the International payroll as Administrative Assistant.

Informant advised that he spoke to HAROLD GIBBONS and GIBBONS was quite upset. GIBBONS told him that LOU POLER, a Miami bank official, has been spreading the story that GIBBONS, STEINBERG and DICK CAWNER were "on the take" and because of this, were dismissed from the Teamsters International Union.
