

On 4/13 and 20/62 attempts were made to contact this informant and it was ascertained that he was out of town on business.

On 4/30/62 informant was contacted by SAA JOSEPH A. ARWINE and he furnished the following information regarding HOMER L. WOXBURG, subject of the case entitled, "HOMER L. WOXBURG, LMRDA - IM," Los Angeles file 159-95, Bufile 159-996:

He stated that he was told by the manager or owner of Aldine Printing Company, Inc., that WOXBURG had bought a piece of Aldine Furniture Company which is located in the same building with Aldine Stationery. Informant stated that most of the locals of the Teamsters Unions in the Los Angeles area purchased their stationery supplies as well as their office equipment from Aldine Company. He stated that he believes that these purchases are made from them due to the influence that WOXBURG had with the Teamsters Union.

He stated that when the health and welfare fund was first initiated in the Teamsters Union that WOXBURG presented a plan to obtain the insurance through Mc Waters Insurance Agency which had just been organized with headquarters located directly across from the Teamsters Building. He stated this plan was opposed by different locals and that health and welfare insurance was not placed with the Mc Waters Agency. He stated there is no question in his mind that MC WATERS made a kickback to WOXBURG since WOXBURG was instrumental in having locals of the Teamsters Union in the Los Angeles area place their car insurance with the Mc Waters Agency as well as fire and theft insurance. He stated that

WOXBERG was behind MC WATERS and he is of the opinion that WOXBERG might own part of the Mc Waters Insurance Agency.

He stated that ~~SALTY DYKES~~, President of Local 224, ~~and~~ an individual who had been very close with WOXBERG, has had a reputation in the past of settling his disputes with the union members through use of force. He stated that he recalls that in the early 1950s that DYKES became angry with a union employee who wanted to make a complaint against his employer and DYKES gave this employee a severe beating. He commented that he does not believe that DYKES has the finesse and intelligence that WOXBERG has and if DYKES believes that anyone could prove he embezzled money that he might possibly talk. CALIF

On 5/15/62 informant telephonically advised that he had received information that ~~SIDNEY COHEN~~, Secretary and Treasurer of Local 208, had attempted to resign his position with that local but through HOFFA's influence he did not resign but went on a leave of absence. He stated COHEN went to Washington and saw HOFFA personally and wanted to resign but HOFFA talked him into staying on until next election which is scheduled in November of 1962. Informant pointed out that Local 208 has always been a trouble spot with HOFFA and that HOFFA wants COHEN to stay on because he feels that COHEN will support him. He stated that an individual by the name of CROYSDILL is president of Local 208 and is presently running the local in COHEN's absence. According to informant, CROYSDILL is the son-in-law of ~~MAJOR RIDDLE~~ of the Dunes Hotel in Las Vegas. CALIF

On 5/22/62 informant telephonically advised that he has received information that GIBBONS, Executive Vice President of the Teamsters Union, and ~~DICK KAVNER~~ of St. Louis, Missouri, together own the Blue Seas Motel in Miami Beach. He stated that he is not positive the name is Blue Seas but believes that is correct. He FUB

stated that he had previously received information that KAVNER was attempting to leave the Teamsters Union but evidentially he has straightened his troubles out with the union and is continuing his activities.
