Enclosed for the Bureau are five copies of a letterhead memorandum setting forth information concerning MATTHEWS.

The Dallas Division is placing this matter in a closed status at this time in that it appears that MATTHEWS has limited his activities and contacts and according to informants he can be found almost every evening at one of the Redman Clubs or the Club Montmarte where he is engaged in low-stake card games.

The Dallas Division has not received any information from sources or informants to indicate that MATTHEWS is presently traveling or associating with police characters other than the gamblers found at the above clubs.
