3. Maintain contact with informants and sources and attempt to develop subject's current activity with regard to the Skyknight Club and whether a front for gambling operations.

ADMINISTRATIVE

On 11/7/66, PCI ALVESTER MAYFIELD advised SA ALAN L. MANNING that he usually has one or two prostitutes working at the Broadway Terrace Motel but they are local girls. He stated he receives calls from other motels and these girls travel by taxi to fill dates. PCI stated that he has sent girls to the Pines Motel near Kilgore, Texas, several times to fill dates. He is aware that RUSSELL TUNNELL operates the Pines Motel and has one or two prostitutes who work there. He stated that NONIE BROWN is unknown to him but he has heard that girls who have worked at the Embers Club in Longview, Texas, as waitresses and entertainers, have gone to the Pines Motel to fill dates of prostitution.

On 9/26/66, DL 208-C stated that he knows MATTHEWS very well but he has no current information regarding MATTHEWS' activities since his arrest by Agents of the Internal Revenue Service in July, 1966.

On 10/20/66, DL 275-C-TE advised with regard to MATTHEWS' arrest by Internal Revenue Service for failure to possess a Federal Wagering Stamp, being engaged in a bookmaking operation, it was his opinion that MATTHEWS had gotten too big and BOSCO or one of his agents had turned MATTHEWS in to Internal Revenue Service. CI advised it is also his opinion that HARRY REMER URBAN, SR. may have also been working with MATTHEWS and he, too, was arrested by Internal Revenue Service some time later. CI had previously advised on the same date that the BOSCO bookmaking operation is laying off heavy to MILTON D. "DUCK" MALLARD at Bryan, Texas, and also to JOHNNY JOSEPH, Austin, Texas, both well-known bookies.
