 SURETE NATIONALE TODAY ADVISED TOURINE STAYED AT PRINCE DE GALLES HOTEL, PARIS, JULY 6 TO 8 LAST. WAS IN CONTACT WITH ONE JOSEF GAVENTA BORN JANUARY 3, 1903 AT LONDON, ENGLAND, A RESIDENT OF 5 SOUTH AUDREY STREET, LONDON. SURETE NATIONALE UNABLE TO FURNISH MORE DETAILS RE ABOVE CONTACT AND SAID GAVENTA UNKNOWN TO THEIR SERVICE. NO INFO AVAILABLE RE TOURINE'S MEANS OF DEPARTURE OR PROPOSED DESTINATION.

SURETE NATIONALE ADVISED NESLINE AND WIFE GLADYS ARRIVED JUNE 28 LAST AND NOT HINKLE AS PREVIOUSLY REPORTED IN REMYCAB. NO INFO DEVELOPED RE NESLINE'S WHEREABOUTS. INVESTIGATION CONTINUING. LONDON ADVISED BY CABLE. COPY TO BERN AND ROME BY POUCH.
