On November 21, 1967, a confidential source advised that during a membership meeting of the Socialist Workers Party, New York Local (SWP - NYL) held November 16, 1967, New York City (NYC), Fred Halstead, a member of the SWP National Committee announced that "We must take the reins of marshaling the December 6th demonstration at Whitehall (United States Armed Forces Induction Center, NYC)".

Halstead stated the SWP's main purpose for being present at the demonstration is to insure cohesive organization in order to make it difficult for the Police to separate the crowd.

The above source advised that Halstead recommended the SWP "should get in the leadership of those in authority" and urged that SWP members become marshals at the demonstration on December 6, 1967.

Halstead emphasized "we must try to have the press take photos to show draftees being escorted or dragged into the Induction Center by cops". He urged use of the "Viet Sign" (Vsign) as it was impressive when used in Berkeley, California, and the anti Dean Rusk demonstration in NYC on November 14, 1967.

On November 24, 1967, a third confidential source advised that a meeting of The Resistance was held on November 22, 1967, at St. Peter's Episcopal Church, NYC, with approximately forty individuals in attendance.

This source advised that representatives from The Resistance, Resist, a NYC anti-draft group and the Fifth Avenue Peace Parade Committee, a NYC Peace Organization were present at this meeting at which Leonard Brody, President of The Resistance, was in Charge.

Source advised plans concerning anti-draft week, December 4- 8, 1967, were discussed which included the turning in of draft cards to a Minister at a NYC Church. The identity of the Minister or Church was not determined.

This source further advised that The Resistance is attempting to rent a storefront in Bronx, New York, to publicize anti-draft week and also plans to open an information center in the vicinity of the Old Chelsea High School, Bronx, New York, for the purpose of encouraging high school students to participate in anti-draft activities and refuse registration with Selective Service Boards.

On November 27, 1967, by means of pretext, a SA of the FBI learned the following concerning anti-draft week from Kipp Dawson, self-identified as a member of Stop The Draft Week Committee, which according to Dawson is an Ad Hoc Coalition representing approximately 50 peace groups and is the Coordinator of anti-draft activities in the NYC area; Edward Fields, self-identified as a member of The Resistance, and David Mc Reynolds, self-identified as Field Secretary of the War Resisters League (WRL) located at 5 Beekman Street, NYC.

On December 4, 1967, at 11:00 a.m. a return of draft cards would occur at St. Paul's Chapel, Trinity Parish, NYC, organized by The Resistance with support from various anti-draft and peace groups.

On December 5, 1967, a sit in with a supporting picket line station coordinated by the WRL would occur 5:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.

The first confidential source advised on November 21, 1967, that Kipp Dawson was then a member of the SWP, NYC.
